

Auditions

Auditions are open to everyone. Successful auditions must be members of Solstice prior to the first rehearsal. It is not required that anyone learn lines or dress up for the audition. The decision to cast will be based on acting alone. Also, you may be asked to try different characters.

After the casting, there will be a read through. It will be an evening with all the cast and production team and their families.

The directors are aware of the tremendous commitment of actors and production team members and work hard to use time productively and make this a rewarding experience.

Some do's and don'ts:

- Do show up on time and stay for the entire audition. Information is given at the beginning and at the end. We may need you so that another part has someone to “act off”.
- Do make sure the directors can see your facial expressions and can hear you.

Now the don'ts:

- Do not wear a costume. The decision will be made on acting alone. Also, you may be asked to try some other parts.
- Do not set your sights on one particular character.
- Do not memorize the script. You will be given the lines to act and it may not be in the script. If it is necessary, you will be able to read the lines. It probably won't be necessary because we are looking at how you act, not how you memorize.

Have a good time, but don't confuse this with taking it seriously!
